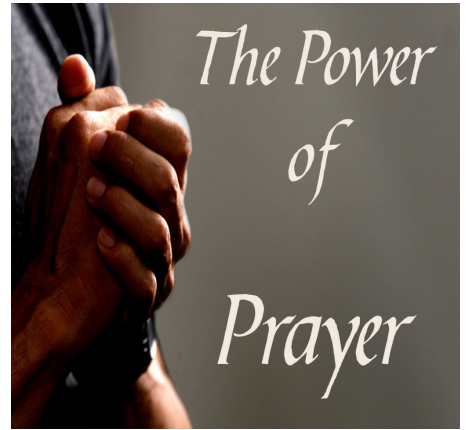
Check the Facebook page for updates and events that are coming up.
